<p><b><i>Personal Safety</i></b>  2) I feel safe before and after school while on school grounds.  11) I feel safe in the lunchroom.  12) I feel safe in the school hallways.  14) I feel safe going to and coming from school.  19) I feel safe in my classrooms.  22) Overall, I feel that this school is a safe school.  23) I feel safe in the bathrooms at school.  24) I feel safe on the playground at school.</p>		
<p><b><i>Belongingness</i></b>  1) I feel that I can talk to a teacher or administrator if I have a problem.  7) I have friends at this school.  10) Teachers listen carefully to what I have to say.  20) I am learning a lot at this school.</p>		
<p><b><i>Effective Learning &amp; General Climate</i></b>  3) Teachers make sure school rules are followed.  13) I am proud of this school.  17) Teachers enjoy teaching here.  18) Students know what behavior is expected of them.  25) Students enjoy learning here.</p>		
<p><b><i>Major Safety Issues</i></b>  *4) Fights among students are common at school.  *5) This year I have had something worth \$10 or more stolen at school.  *6) Some students are regularly beaten up by other students.  *9) I have seen a gun at school this year.  *16) I have seen a knife at school (not including a cafeteria knife).</p>		
<p><b><i>Incivility / Disruption</i></b>  *8) Threats by one student against another are common at school.  *15) Name calling, insults or teasing happen regularly at school.  *21) Arguments among students are common at school.</p>
