Subscale on Safe Schools Survey		
<i>Personal Safety</i> 1) Overall, I feel that this school is a safe school. 8) My child feels safe in the lunchroom. 9) My child feels safe in the school hallways 11) My child feels safe going to and coming from school. 19) My child feels safe in the classrooms at school.		
<i>Belongingness</i> 14) My child feels he/she belongs at this school. 17) My child has friends at this school. 27) My child feels that teachers care about him or her as a person.		
<i>Effective Learning & General Climate</i> 3) School rules seem reasonable. 4) Students know what behavior is expected of them. 5) I feel welcome at my child's school. 6) My son or daughter is proud of his or her school. 15) School rules are clearly defined and explained so that I can understand them. 18) Parents are informed when a student has a discipline problem at school. 23) Teachers make sure school rules are followed. 24) I feel teachers care about my child's learning. 25) Parents are involved in activities at school.		
<i>Personal School Experience</i> 2) My child is getting a good education at this school. 7) My son or daughter is proud of his or her school. 21) My child is learning a lot at this school.		
<i>Major Safety Issues</i> *12) Physical fighting or conflicts happen regularly at school. *16) This year my child has had something worth \$10 or more stolen at school.		
<i>Incivility / Disruption</i> *10) Threats by one student against another are common at school. *13) Name calling, insults or teasing happen regularly at school. *22) Arguments among students are common at school.		

Represents mean on a five point scale: 1=Strongly Disagree, 5=Strongly Agree. Items were rescaled for mean analysis so that higher numbers are always positive.
